Naloxone NOW is a statewide public awareness campaign addressing illegal opioid use and the stigma related to naloxone use for opioid overdose. We are excited about the next phase of the campaign and are seeking your assistance for its success.

Prevention First is searching for Illinois adults who have been revived by naloxone (i.e. Narcan), the opioid overdose antidote medication, who are now leading successful lives and are willing to share their experience.
