


Intervene and Monitor



Give full 8-12 mg bup daily dose before surgery and manage breakthrough pain after surgery by increasing along spectrum of multimodal approach available in order set (e.g., Heat/Ice \rightarrow Acetaminophen/Gabapentin/NSAIDs → Hydromorphone/Fentanyl → Ketamine). Consult with Pain Expert if available.



Pain **Expert**

With full agonists opioids, patients on bup require higher total doses. Consider allowing patients to frequently administer these medications in small doses via PCAs. Monitor CO₂ levels to detect respiratory depression.

Before discharge, trial the outpatient medication regimen to assure proper pain management in a controlled setting.
